#### **Co-op Member Access**

Full personal use of the open studio workspace and all equipment in community area, discount on classes *and* workshops.

- Assigned storage space (i.e. flat storage/cubby space)
- Members in good standing may be included in OGS-member exhibitions
- Co-op membership requires approximately 1 hour volunteer time (or equivalent) per month through the upkeep of facilities. A monthly task will be assigned at the contract signing. Tasks can rotate every 3 mo.
- Members can rent an additional flat file for \$5/mo will space permits. Inquire about additional storage rental
- Green Room access is available by reservation and co-op members receive a discounted rate.
  - Oco-op members who provide 3+ hours volunteer time per month, beyond their monthly tasks, can gain full access to this room on a month-to-month basis.
- Co-op members willingly accept and respect the OGS Guiding Principals (see reverse side)
